### TO MY PARISHIONERS:



For their devotion and dedication to things of God, Church and Parish;

1945 Corporation member and Trustee of the Orchard Lake Institutions;  
1945 Diocesan Deputy in Disciplinary matters at Orchard Lake for 25 years;

1945 Liaison between the Polish American Medical-Dental Arts Assoc. through the combined efforts and most generous cooperation of Mrs. L. Auberlin, President of the World Medical Relief, medicines and surgical supplies were sent to Poland in the sum of \$170,000;

1945 Member of the Board and Chairman of the St. Mary's Home for the Aged Building Committee;










