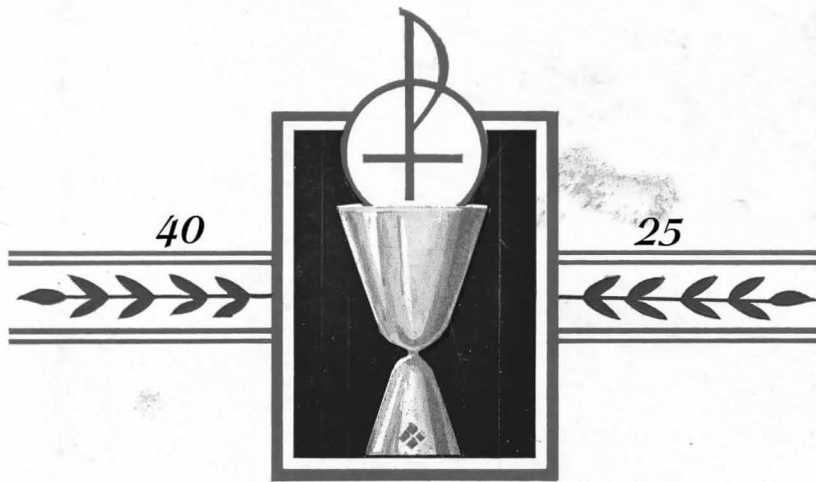

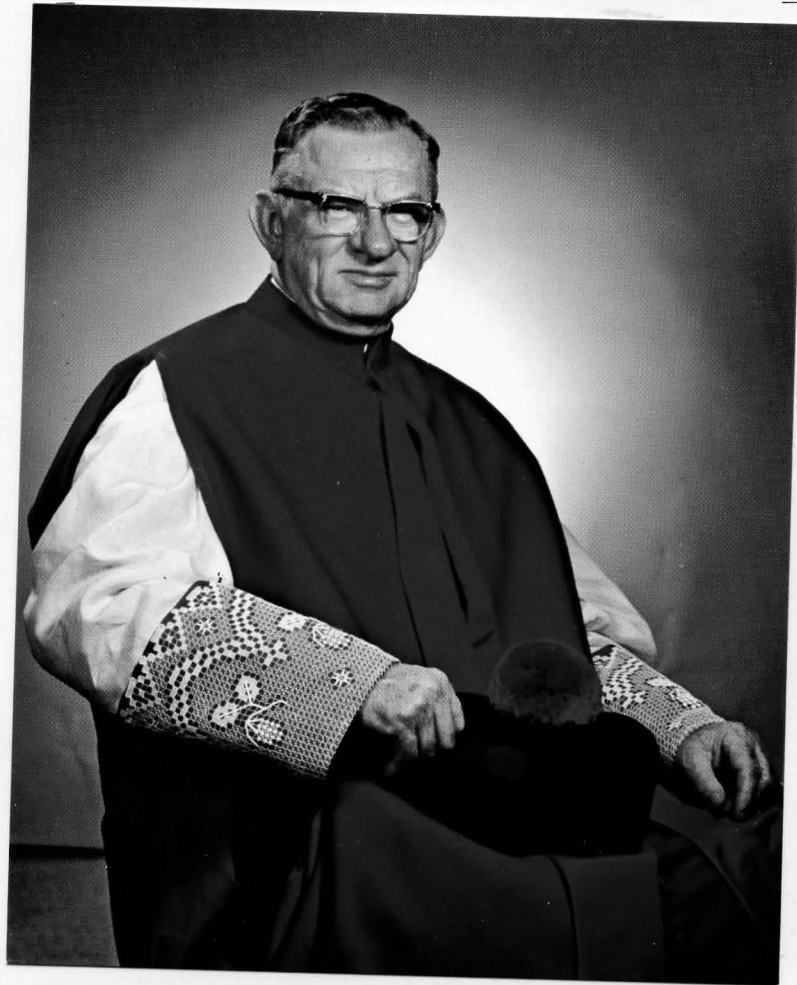


In a letter that I received today from His Excellency, the Apostolic Delegate, I have been informed that the Holy Father has graciously granted to you the dignity of a Domestic Prelate. It is with particular pleasure that I transmit this information to you and offer you at the same time my most earnest congratulations. The honor that has come to you is a merited recognition of your devoted service to the Archdiocese.

Public announcement of this recognition will be made early next week. In the meantime, I ask that you begin to make plans for your public investiture in your new robes in a ceremony to be held at Blessed Sacrament Cathedral on Sunday, September 30, at 3:00 p.m.

The early date that has been set for your investiture will entail a certain amount of inconvenience. I know that you will recognize that it is due to the fact that this is the last possible date that can be chosen prior to my departure for Rome. It is for this reason that it will be necessary to proceed a bit more rapidly than would ordinarily be the case.

I am very happy to join many others in congratulations to you from myself and the people of Hamtramck on this happy occasion of your recent appointment by His Holiness as a Monsignor.



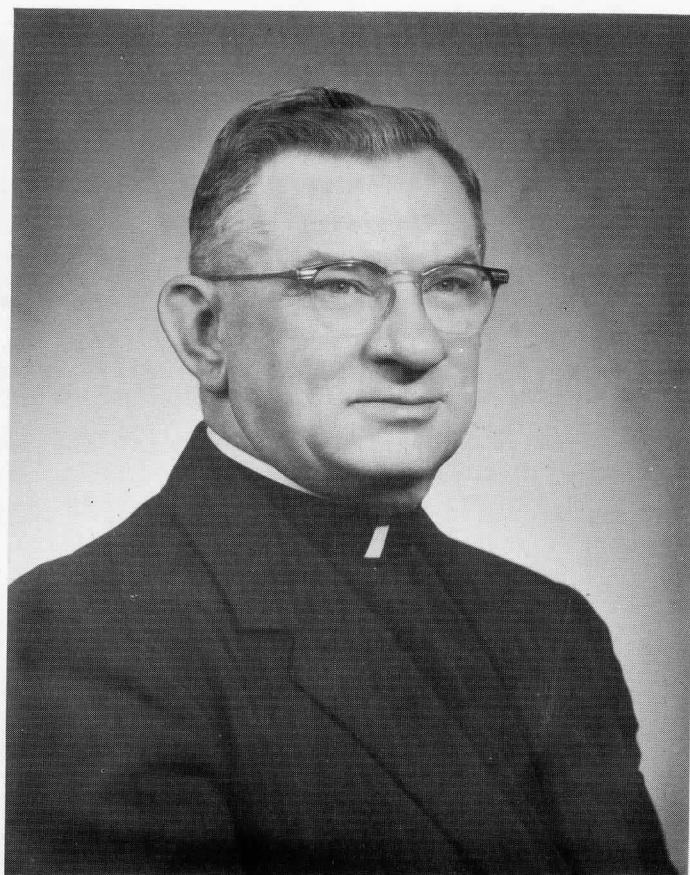

The Right Reverend Monsignor Peter P. Walkowiak

Peter P. Walkowiak, Priest - Pastor - Dean - Monsignor

The first child of Valentine and Anna Walkowiak, our Right Reverend Pastor was born in Detroit on June 29, 1896. He attended Saint Stanislaus Grade school and in 1912, was enrolled at the University of Detroit. Five years later he entered Saint Mary's College at Orchard Lake to begin his Seminary career. He took his theological training at Saints Cyril and Methodius Seminary at Orchard Lake. This terminated with his ordination to the Priesthood on September 10, 1922, conferred by the Most Reverend Michael J. Gallagher, then Bishop of Detroit. As a newly ordained Priest, Father Walkowiak's first appointment was that of Assistant Pastor at Saint Stephen's in Detroit. After three years of service there, he was transferred to Saint Francis of Assisi Parish. This was followed by an appointment as full time Chaplain at Saint Francis Hospital in Hamtramck. In 1928, Father Walkowiak was named Pastor of Our Lady Help of Christians Parish where he spent ten years devoting his energy and zeal to his people and especially to the parish youth. On July 27, 1938, His Eminence, Edward Cardinal Mooney appointed him Pastor of Saint Florian's Parish. Continuing his interest in the education of the young, the new Pastor set himself to the task of establishing Saint Florian's High School and four years later its foundation, our High School received its treasured accreditation from the University of Michigan.

With the organization of the High School, Father Walkowiak foresaw the need of a separate building which would serve as an annex to the school and also fill the need for recreational facilities. This dream materialized in July of 1951, when ground was broken for Saint Florian's new Educational Center. The dedication of this half million dollar edifice took place on September 21, 1952.

With an accredited High School and adequate educational facilities, Father Walkowiak then provided improved and quite modern living quarters for the Felician Sisters who staff our parish schools. The presentation of this new convent marked the high point of Saint Florian's celebration of its Fiftieth Anniversary.

Recognizing the untiring efforts and outstanding achievements of the Pastor of Saint Florian, His Excellency, Archbishop John F. Dearden appointed Father Walkowiak Dean of the newly created Wayne Northeast Central Deanery. His title was that of "Very Reverend". This distinction was soon followed by another, this time conferred upon our Pastor by the Pope himself. On September 7, 1962, His Holiness, Pope John XXIII raised Father Walkowiak to the dignity of a Domestic Prelate.

Monsignor Walkowiak has been especially active in civic affairs and Church organizational work. After the war he served as Archdiocesan Director of Immigration, succeeding Bishop Woznicki who previously held that post. In 1955, Father Walkowiak was among the Organizers and the first President of the Archdiocesan Priests for Polish Affairs. At present he is National Vice-Chaplain of the Polish Roman Catholic Union. He is a Director and a Member of the Board of Trustees of Saints Cyril and Methodius Seminary and Saint Mary's College at Orchard Lake. He has held the same position at the Guardian Angel Home in Detroit for twenty-five years. His civic work includes the position of Chairman of the Recreation Commission of the City of Hamtramck and also of the State Welfare Commission. He serves as Chaplain to various Veteran and Civic Organizations.

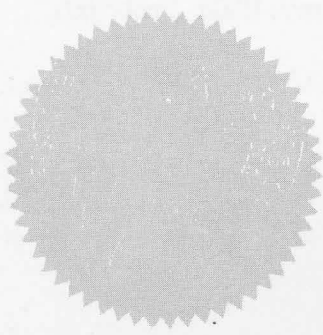
