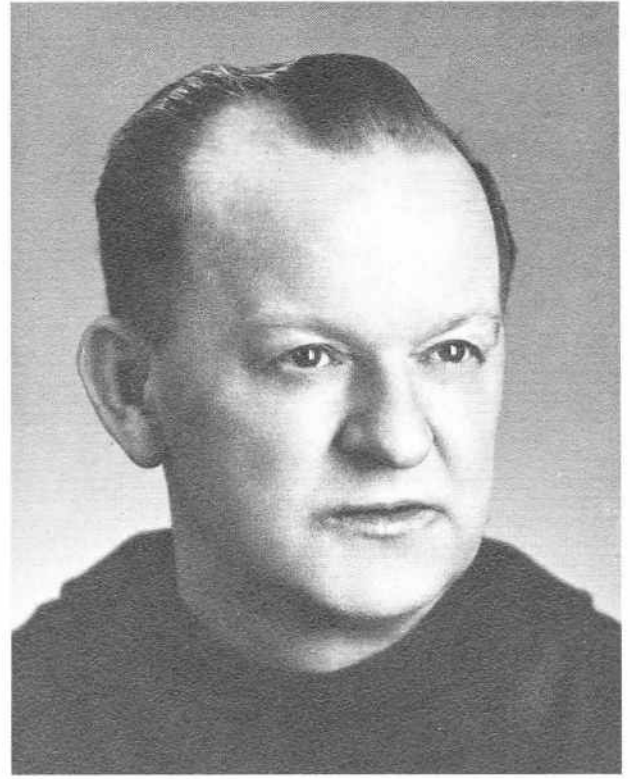


Dear Parishioners:

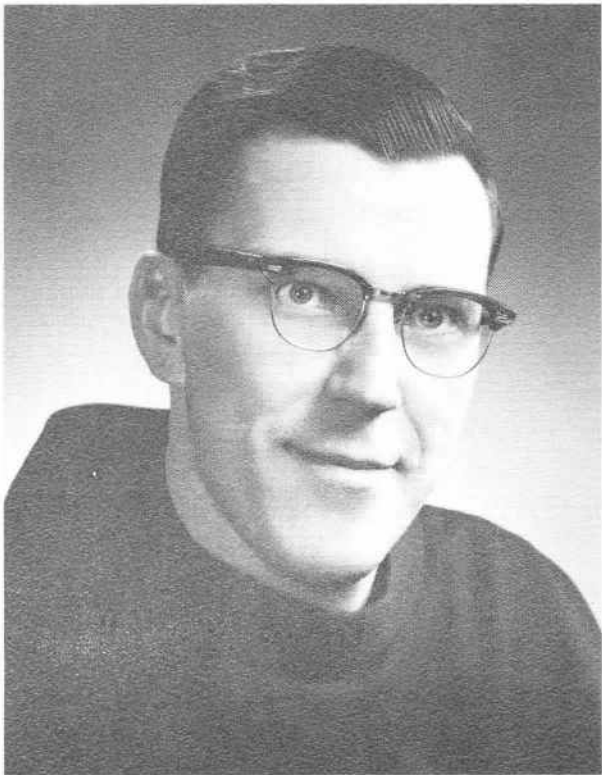

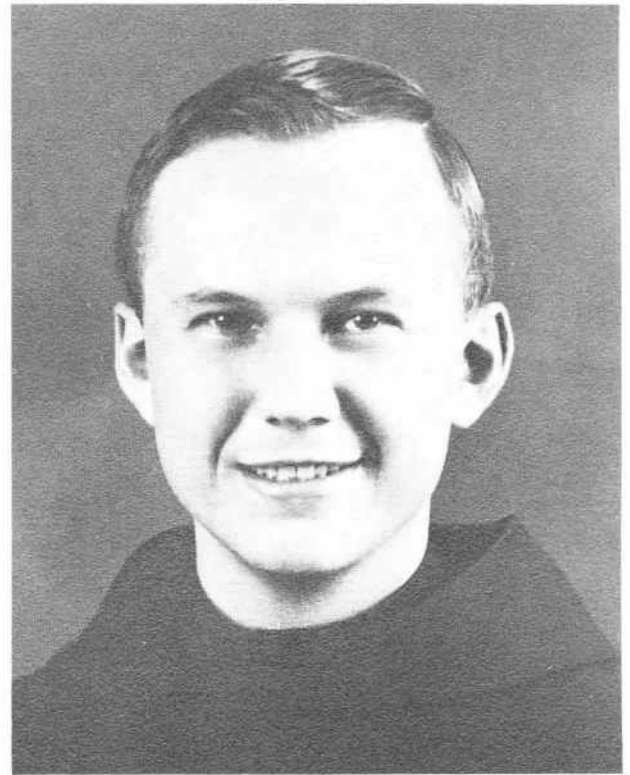

KRÓTKA HISTORIA PARAFII M. B. ANIELSKIEJ

Na prośbę Katolickich mieszkańców okolicy, Biskup Foley z Detroit udzielił pozwolenie Ojcom Franciszkanom, kierownikom sąsiedniej parafii św. Jadwigi, na założenie nowej parafii w dzielnicy ulic Edward i Michigan. Ówczesny Prowincjał, Przew. O. Jacek Fudzinski, naznaczył Ojca Rajmunda Marciniac, wikarego w parafii św. Jadwigi, na zapoczątkowanie nowego dzieła.

Więc O. Rajmund zakupił potrzebny grunt i architekt narysował plany na zbudowanie kościoła w suterenie i sześć klas ponad kościołem. Budowę rozpoczęto w lipcu 1915 roku, a kościół był poświęcony pod tytułem Matki Boskiej Anielskiej, dnia 8-go grudnia, 1915 r.

Chwilowo, Siostry Felicjanki, mieszkające w parafii św. Jadwigi, rozpoczęły uczyć dzieci szkolne w styczniu, 1916 r. O. Rajmund tymczasem mieszkał w jednej z próżnych klas szkolnych. W lecie, roku 1916, O. Rajmund zakupił dom na klasztor dla Sióstr, które miały w nim na jesień zamieszkać. O. Jacek Fudzinski miał życzenie, aby Siostry Franciszkanek z Hamburg, N.Y., przyjęły na siebie obowiązek nauczycielek w szkole. Pierwsza przełożona była Siostra Salomea. Ponieważ dzieci zajęły wszystkie klasy, O. Rajmund wynajął mieszkanie przy ulicach Waldo i Martin. W roku 1919 dodano drugie piętro do powiększającej się szkoły.

Gdy O. Rajmund został przeniesiony do Shamokin, Pa., na kapitułę w roku 1920, O. Wenanty Szulc był naznaczony proboszczem. On zbudował siostron klasztor w roku 1926. Wielebni Ojcowie przenieśli się do dawniejszego klasztoru Sióstr, sprzedając wpierw swą plebanię rodzinie Stempień.

Po śmierci O. Wenantego Szulc, dnia 17-go listopada 1929 r., O. Rajmund napowrót podjął obowiązki proboszcza. W tym czasie zakupił 7 dodatkowych lot, spłacił dług, odmalował plebanię i kościół. Jako proboszcz obchodził Srebrny Jubileusz parafii w roku 1940. Po nim proboszczem został w roku 1942, Przew. O. Eustachy Bartoszewicz, dawniejszy Prowincjał i proboszcz parafii św. Jadwigi, który rządził parafią przez następne 3 lata. Gdy O. Eustachy wrócił do swej rodzinnej prowincji na wschodzie, O. Pius Kałużny nastąpił po nim, jako proboszcz w roku 1945.

W roku 1948 O. Paweł Czubaj przybył tu z Milwaukee. Był on proboszczem przez trzy terminy do roku 1957. O. Paweł zbudował obecny piękny kościół i plebanię, jakoteż i szkołę parafialną, oraz obszerne miejsce na parkowanie samochodów, zasadził także wiele pięknych drzew i zasiał prześliczną trawę. Łamanie gruntu pod nowy kościół i plebanię miało miejsce 29-go października, 1950 r.; Ks. Prałat Tobias Morin umieścił kamień węgielny, dnia 26-go października, 1952 r. Nowe ołtarze były konsekrowane przez Biskupa Sufragana Aleksandra Zaleski z Detroit, 6-go marca, 1952 r.

Ziszczenie się wysiłków O. Pawła było uwieńczone dedykacją kościoła przez Ks. Kardynała Edwarda Mooney, dnia 8-go marca, 1953 r. Później nowa szkoła była poświęcona przez Biskupa Sufragana Henryka E. Donnelly z Detroit.

O. Zygmunt Grochowski zajął miejsce O. Pawła od roku 1957 do 1960; wystawił on na podwórku parafialnym Grotę Matki Bożej z Fatmy i odbudował front starego budynku, w którym mieścił się kościół i szkoła. Obecny proboszcz O. Kalikst Winiarz, przybył tu w roku 1960. Dał on gustownie wymalować kościół pędzlem znanego artysty-malarza Polskiego p. Karola Malczyk i porobił inne pochwały godne ulepszenia.



BRIEF HISTORY OF OUR LADY QUEEN OF ANGELS PARISH

At the request of the Catholic residents of the area, Bishop Foley of Detroit granted permission to the Franciscan Fathers, already in charge of the neighboring parish, St. Hedwig, to organize a new parish in the area of Michigan Avenue and Edward Street. The Minister Provincial, Fr. Hyacinth Fudzinski, assigned Fr. Raymond Marciniak, assistant at St. Hedwig, the task of launching the new project.

He purchased land, therefore, and an architect drew the plans for a basement church with six classrooms above. Construction began in July, 1915; the church was blessed under the title of Our Lady Queen of Angels on December 8, 1915.

Temporarily the Felician Sisters, who resided at St. Hedwig Parish, began to teach the children in January, 1916. The pastor meanwhile lived in one of the empty classrooms. In the summer of 1916, Fr. Raymond bought a home to serve as a convent for the Sisters scheduled to occupy it in the fall. It was Fr. Hyacinth's wish that the Franciscan Sisters of Hamburg, New York, assume the task of teaching; Sister Salomea was their first superior. Because the children needed all six classrooms, Fr. Raymond rented half a house on Waldo and Martin Avenues, but in 1917 he was able to buy a more suitable rectory opposite the school on Martin Avenue. In 1919 a second floor was added above the expanding school.

With the transfer of Fr. Raymond to Shamokin, Pennsylvania, after the chapter of 1920, Fr. Venantius Szulc was appointed pastor. He constructed the sisters permanent convent in 1926. The fathers moved into the sisters former convent, their own friary having been sold to the Stempien family.

Upon Fr. Szulc's death on November 17, 1929, Fr. Raymond again assumed the pastor's duties. During this time he bought seven additional lots, paid off the remaining debt, painted the rectory and church, and began a fund for the new church. As pastor he celebrated the parish's Silver Jubilee in 1940. Fr. Eustace Bartoszewicz, former provincial and pastor of St. Hedwig, succeeded him during the trentium beginning in 1942. With the return of Fr. Eustace to his native province in the east, Fr. Pius Kaluzny became pastor in 1945.

In 1948, Fr. Paul Czuba arrived here from Milwaukee. He remained the pastor for three terms until 1957. Fr. Paul built the present beautiful stone church and rectory, as well as the new school and parking lot with appropriate landscaping. The breaking of ground for the new plant took place on October 29, 1950; Msgr. Tobias Morin laid the cornerstone on October 26, 1952. New altars were consecrated by Auxiliary Bishop Alexander Zaleski of Detroit on March 6, 1953. The fulfillment of Fr. Paul's efforts was the dedication of the church by Cardinal Mooney on March 8, 1953. Subsequently the new school was also blessed by auxiliary Bishop Donnelly of Detroit.

Fr. Sigmund Grochowski succeeded Fr. Paul in 1957 until 1960; he built the outdoor grotto of Our Lady of Fatima and rebuilt the facade of the old church-school building. The incumbent is Fr. Callistus Winiarz, here since 1960. He had the church decorated in good taste by a prominent Polish artist, Karol Malczyk.

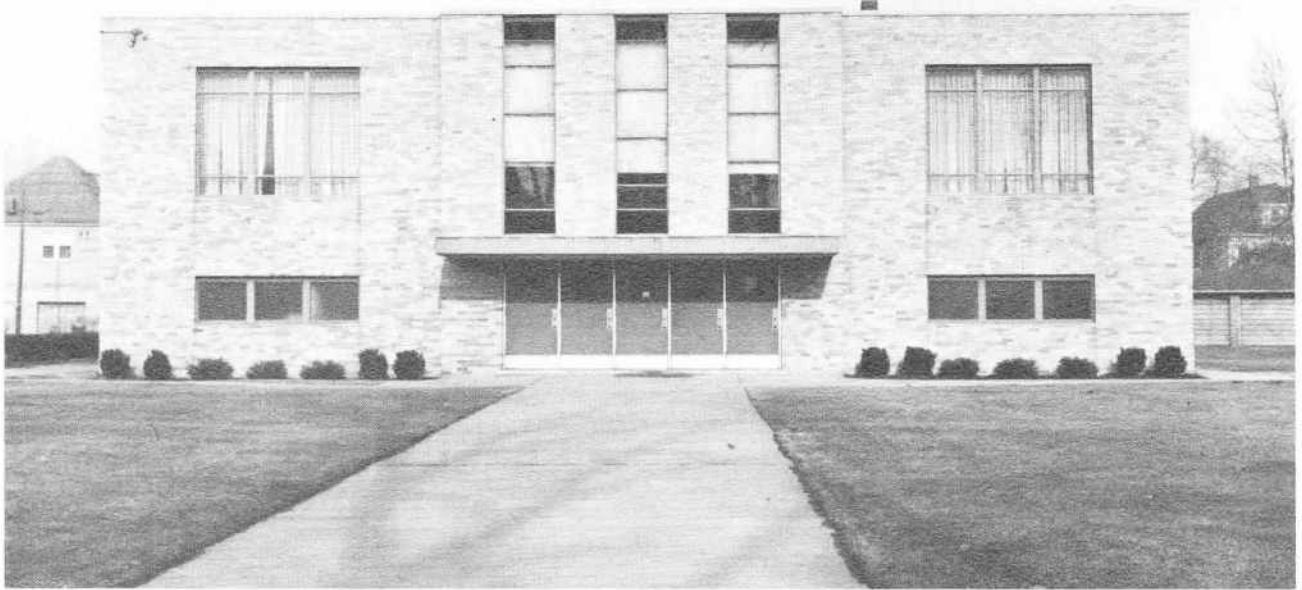

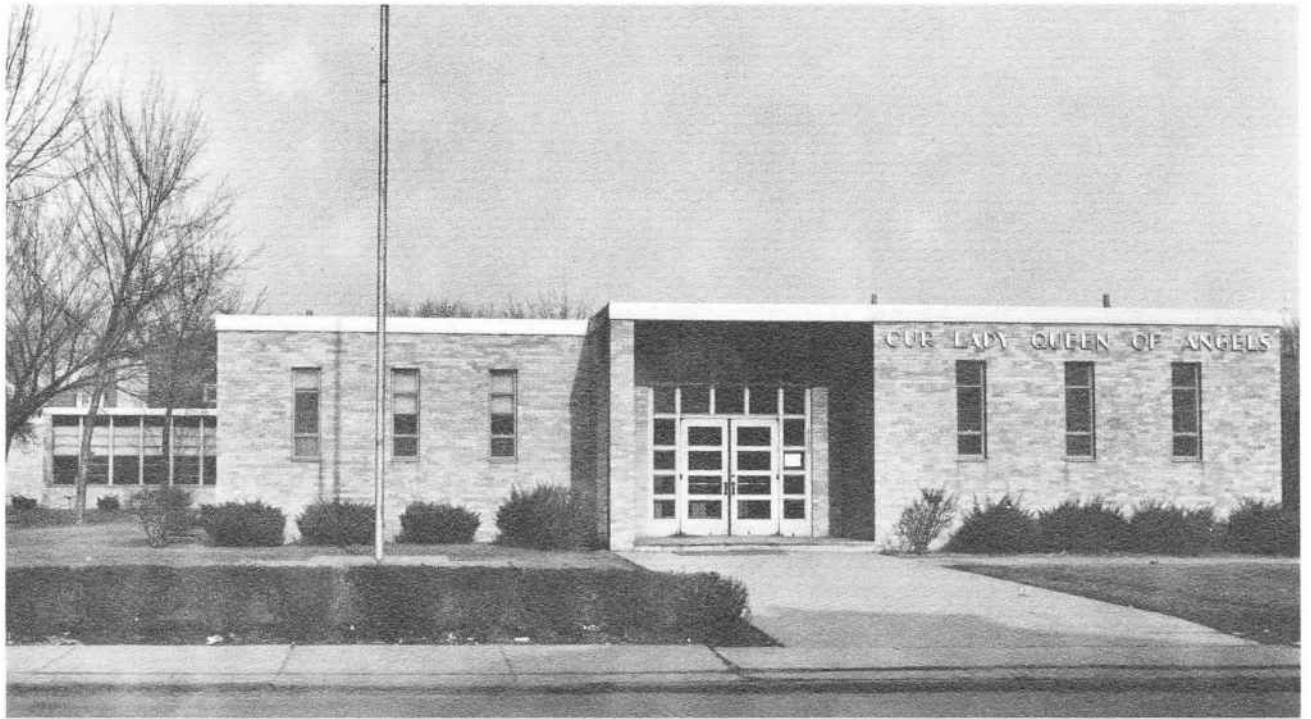
