The Reverend Roman Klafkowski is hereby appointed first Pastor of the Polish Parish which will be established in Hamtramck by cutting off the northeastern portion of the present Parish of St. Florian . . .

With these few simple words, Our Lady Queen of Apostles became a parish 60 years ago, and a viable, progressive and faithful family was born.

From a modest beginning in a two-story house on Prescott Street, a mere 25 families have grown to nearly 2000 families.

During our 60 years, we have been led with faithful service by six pastors:

Rev. R. Klafkowski, 1917-1922
Rev. Z. Dziatkiewicz, 1922-1925
Rev. S. Wasilewski, 1925-1940
Rev. L. Szok, 1940-1967
Rev. A. Madeja, 1967-1969
Rev. T. Blaszczyk, 1970 to the present.

Rev. Fr. Klafkowski was instrumental in purchasing thirty-two parcels of real estate and supervising construction of the first school, Sister's convent, temporary church and rectory.

Our school has been blessed by 60 years of educational guidance and service of the Felician Sisters.

In 1927, under the pastorate of Fr. Wasielewski, our present school building was constructed along with the temporary church.

During the pastorate of Fr. Szok, the rectory was completed and the present Sister's Convent was built. His most notable accomplishment was the construction of our beautiful church which was blessed by Edward Cardinal Mooney on November 23, 1952.

Mere construction did not satisfy Fr. Szok so he highlighted our church with the sanctuary screen behind the main altar, mosaic work in the sanctuary, side altars and other portions of the Church. One of the finest pipe organs in the Detroit area - a Casavant - with 2187 pipes - was installed in the choir loft.

Fr. Madeja made major repairs and renovations in our school and appointed the first parish council to implement the directives of the Vatican Council.

Through parish organizations, our members have worked diligently for the spiritual development of our family and the material advancement of our parish. The oldest of our organizations is the Third Order of St. Francis, the youngest is the Ladies' Auxiliary. Between them are the Rosary Society, Christian

Mothers, Archconfraternity of the Sacred Heart, Altar Society, Holy Name Society, Choir and Usher's Club. For our youngest we have Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts and the Polish American Youth Club. Our Senior Citizens meet each week for lively discussions and Bingo playing. Pre-schoolers and public school students come for Religious classes. To the delight of our cheer-leaders, our athletes pursue baseball and basketball. Our students present exhibits and entertaining programs. Our Festival Committee has made our Annual Festival the showplace of such activities while providing needed financial assistance to our school. Our Tuesday and Wednesday Bingo Committees have provided amply to our treasury. Little wonder that our Parish is bursting with activity. Our Choir is renowned and admired throughout the State.

Spiritually, the parish is equally active. Sunday and weekday Masses are attended by a joyful, participating congregation. Additional Church services such as Novenas, Lenten and Marian Devotions, Forty Hours Devotion, First Communions, Easter and Christmas celebrations still retain much of the old fervor, style and customs that our earlier founders brought with them from Poland. The parish has also participated in much that is new and progressive: synods, discussions and adult education courses, conferences, folk masses, retreats and Bible Studies.



Our present pastor, Fr. Ted Blaszczyk, came to us in February, 1970. His greatest challenge has been to keep our school open in the face of rampant inflation and rising costs. Under his guidance, our first elected Parish Council took office. Fr. Blaszczyk has guided our spiritual development in line with the directives of the Vatican Council. His pastorate has resulted in Queen of Apostles becoming a forward-looking parish, sensitive to the varied needs of its members, all age groups, backgrounds and view points. Fr. Blaszczyk also holds the elected post of Vicar of the North Central Vicariate, providing his proven leadership to 17 sister Parishes and one hospital.


Look around you, 60 years has left us much in which to take pride while thanking God for his blessings upon us.


REV. FRANK WOŁOSZYK

REV. GEORGE KOWALSKI

Father George was born in Poland and was ordained to the priesthood in Krakow on June 29, 1959. He served as a pastor and associate pastor while in Poland. Prior to coming to Our Lady Queen of Apostles he was at St. Aloysius in Romulus, Michigan. Father George has been at Our Lady Queen of Apostles since June of 1976.

Fr. Ted Blaszczyk, the son of Stanley and Sophia (Pason), was born March 5, 1927 in Hamtramck in the parish of St. Florian, where he was baptized and attended the parochial school.

He completed his high school and college education at Sacred Heart Seminary and theology at SS. Cyril & Methodius Seminary at Orchard Lake, Michigan.

Father Blaszczyk was ordained by Edward Cardinal Mooney on June 5, 1953. He offered his First Solemn Mass at St. Florian Church on June 6, 1953.

He served as assistant at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel in Wyandotte, SS. Peter & Paul, St. Stanislaus and Sacred Heart in Detroit. In 1968 he was appointed Chaplain at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit.

On February 18, 1970, John Cardinal Dearden appointed him pastor of Our Lady Queen of Apostles in Hamtramck, Michigan.

Since his appointment as pastor, Father Ted has served as Vicar of the North Central Vicariate which is comprised of some 17 parishes and one hospital.

NA 60-lecie PARAFII

Był to pamiętny dzień 1-go maja. Rok 1917. Ks. Roman Klafkowski, asystent przy parafii św. Wojciecha w Detroit, otrzymał tytuł proboszcza i obowiązek wybudowania nowej parafii polskiej tam, gdzie dziś jest kwitnące Apostołowo Archidiecezja Detroicką rządził wówczas ks. arcybiskup Jan Foley. Dokoła młodego proboszcza skupiło się na początku tylko 25 rodzin polskich. To był założek parafii, którą oddano pod opiekę Królowej Apostołów.

Na wieść o powstającej nowej parafii polskiej w Hamtramck, zaczęto osiedlać się w pobliżu coraz więcej Polaków. Gorliwy młody proboszcz rozpoczął już w początkach maja 1917 roku odprawiać Msze św. i majowe nabożeństwa w dwupiętrowym domu przy ulicy Prescott, zakupionym przez parafian św. Wojciecha, który był w początkach plebanią i kościołem zarazem. Kilka miesięcy później otwarto już szkołę parafialną dla dzieci, prowadzoną przez siostry Felicjanki w dwóch domach prywatnych, a rok później w maju 1918 r. istniała już nowa 8-klasowa szkoła parafialna. W tym samym roku wybudowano także dom dla sióstr.

Prace proboszcza wspierały wydatnie organizacje kościelne, które powstały w pierwszych miesiącach budującej się parafii. Najstarszy jest Trzeci Zakon św. Franciszka, założony w maju 1917 roku, trochę później powstało Bractwo Różanca, potem Tow. Michała Archanioła i Sodalicia Panien. Inne dziś istniejące powstały później; Towarzystwo Ołtarza w roku 1926-tym; Tow. Imienia Jezus w maju 1928, a Tow. Matek Chrześcijańskich 20-go lipca 1928 r.

Tempo rozkwitu parafii powstrzymała groźna influenza, szalejąca w Detroit i okolicy w r. 1918 i 1919, która dość mocno przerzędziła szeregi parafian na Apostołowie. Śmierć zabrała także wielu gorliwych i bliskich współpracowników proboszcza.

Po pięciu latach wyczerpującej i bogatej w zasługi pracy, to jest w roku 1922 ks. Roman Klafkowski odszedł na emeryturę i jako 94-letni starzec przeżywał osobiście na Apostołowie 50 letnią rocznicę parafii, pod którą kładł ongiś fundament.

Po nim przyszedł na krótki czas ks. Zygmunt Dziatkiewicz, a w roku 1925 proboszczem na Apostołowie został ks. Stanisław Wasilewski, który tu gospodarzył aż do roku 1940. W pierwszych latach swoich rządów, pomimo czasów kryzysowych, rozbudował istniejącą skromną szkołę parafialną i połączył ją z kościołem pod jednym dachem za sumę \$120,000. A w roku 1938 zbudowano obecną plebanię za \$24,000.

Ogromny rozmach jego pracy przerwała śmierć. A kronika parafialna zanotowała, że zmarł na atak serca

z przemęczenia i kłopotów, przeżywszy 50 lat zaledwie.

Po śmierci ks. St. Wasilewskiego kardynał Mooney przysiąał ks. Władysława Szoka, proboszcza z sąsiedniej parafii Zmartwychwstania, który przez 27 lat gospodarzył na Apostołowie. Za jego czasów parafia obchodziła 25-lecie istnienia. Uroczystą sumę odprawił wówczas ks. R. Klafkowski w obecności ks. biskupa Wozniaka.


Ks. prob. Szok spłacił długi parafialne i wybudował za gotówkę nowy kościół w roku 1952 za sumę \$850,000. Za jego czasów była druga wojna światowa, w której 1,300 młodych parafian Polaków walczyło w szeregach armii Stanów Zjednoczonych. On także przygotował obchód 50-lecia parafii w maju 1967 r. Uroczystą sumę odprawił proboszcz Szok w obecności kard. Dearden'a i staruszka założyciela tej parafii ks. R. Klafowskiego. Kazanie w dwóch językach wygłosił ks. prałat Walerian Jasinski, profesor z Orchard Lake. W miesiąc po obchodzie 50-lecia parafii ks. prob. Szok przeszedł na emeryturę, zamieszkiwać nadal w plebanii na Apostołowie.

Po nim przyszedł ks. Alfons Madeja 15-go czerwca 1967 roku. Gospodarzył nieco ponad dwa lata. Śmierć go zabrała w wieku 65 lat. Pogrzeb jego odbył się w ostatni dzień starego roku 1969. W tym krótkim czasie energiczny proboszcz odnowił szkołę parafialną za sumę \$100,000, polepszył parkowisko parafialne i umieblował więcej nowoczesnie plebanię.


Jako szósty proboszcz na Apostołowie, ks. Tadeusz Błaszczyk, rozpoczął urzędowanie 18-go lutego 1970 roku. Kardynał Dearden przysiąał tym razem na życzenie Rady Parafialnej młodszego kapłana, liczącego 42 lat. W tym roku upływa siedem lat jego urzędowania. Ks. prob. T. Błaszczyk pochował w naszym kościele dwóch poprzednich proboszczów: założyciela Apostołowa ks. Romana Klafowskiego /97 lat/, którego pogrzeb odbył się 3-go grudnia 1970 roku, a 30-go grudnia 1972 ks. Władysława Szoka /78 lat/.

Widoczne są wszędzie ślady pięknej pracy obecnego proboszcza. Ale historia nie lubi wystawiać pomników za życia. Rozdział jego pracy nie jest jeszcze zamknięty, więc historyk musi czekać.... przynajmniej aż do roku 1992, kiedy to Apostołowo obchodzić będzie 75-ta rocznicę swego istnienia. I należy życzyć sobie, aby obecny proboszcz nie tylko doczekał się tej historycznej chwili, ale ja przygotował równie starannie i z rozmachem jak obecne 60-lecie.



Wladyslaw Budweil

Our organist Wladyslaw Budweil was born March 25, 1921 in Sanok, Poland.

After his family moved to Krakow, he began studying the organ under the renowned Franciszek Przystala and also continued studying voice and conducting under the well known composer-conductor Boleslaw Wallek-Walewski.

After the war broke out in 1939, he was arrested by the Gestapo for playing and singing patriotic hymns in the Carmelites' Church, where he was organist. In 1940, he was imprisoned in the Auschwitz concentration camp. In 1943 he was transferred to Buchenwald and then to Schoenbeck. He was freed May 3, 1945 by American armed forces. He stayed in Lubeck until 1950 while continuing his education and teaching music.

In 1950 he came to the United States with his wife and daughter and settled in Detroit. On September 1, 1950, he became the organist at Queen of

Apostles Church. Here he began his work of developing the parish choir and continuing his organ studies under August Conen. During the summers he attended courses sponsored by the Archdiocese, under such conductors as Christiansen and Peloquin.

Mr. Budweil is active in the community beyond the parish boundaries. He organized the "Haslo" PNA Choir and conducted the "Millennium" Choir. At the present time he is conductor of the Filarets Choir. He is an active member of the Friends of Polish Art, the Polish National Alliance, the Alliance of Poles of America, the Polish Falcons of America, and the Polish American Congress. Mr. Budweil's life has been a full and active life, devoted to his family, his parish and his Polish heritage. His dedicated service to music and harmony has enriched Queen of Apostles and our entire community.

The Choir of Our Lady Queen of Apostles, under the direction of Wladyslaw Budweil is composed of dedicated men and women who give glory to God by singing. The choir's popularity continues to grow each year. They have appeared on a television program presenting Polish Christmas Carols as well as on radio station WMZK. They participated in a Mass celebrated on the occasion of the Convention of the Polish American Congress, the 100th Anniversary of the Polish Roman Catholic Union and convention of the Polish Singers Alliance in America. Other performances included the opening and closing ceremonies during the Holy Year Pilgrimage, the 50th Anniversary of the City of Hamtramck, trips to St. Anthony's Parish in Belleville, Michigan and St. Anne's Parish in Warren, Michigan. The choir participated in the First Mass celebrated by our former deacon, Fr.

Gerald Borawski in Cleveland, Ohio and also in pre-game ceremonies on Polish Night at Tiger Stadium. Perhaps the greatest highlight of the choir was to honor their Director and Organist, Mr. Budweil, on his Silver Jubilee in the parish celebrated at a banquet in his honor on April 27, 1976.

During the Bicentennial Year of 1976, the choir actively participated in various programs in its own parish, in the city of Hamtramck, the campus of Orchard Lake and at St. Alber-tus Parish at a Mass concelebrated by Polish Bishops visiting the United States for the Eu-charistic Congress.

The choir achieved great success during the last 25 years under the able direction of Walter Budweil, not to mention the time, effort and sacrifice given by its members.



Originally the Felician Sisters came to America in 1874. In 1936 the present provincial house was constructed on a 230 acre site in Livonia Township. Additional buildings were added and today, the provincial house forms the core of a complex of buildings, including Madonna College, Ladywood High, St. Mary Hospital, and Maria Nursery. The Felician Sisters are found teaching in various schools around the States of Michigan, Ohio and Indiana.
