



History of St. Edmund Parish

On June 21, 1961 St. Edmund Parish was established by decree of His Grace, John F. Dearden, D.D., Archbishop of Detroit. Father William J. McGoldrick was appointed the founding pastor, and served until his retirement from active priesthood on June 22, 1988. The social hall was named the Fr. McGoldrick Center in recognition of the years he served at St. Edmund Church.

We have been blessed to be served by many priests, deacons and nuns who have enriched our lives.

Our current Pastor Father Robert J. Witkowski, has been with St. Edmund Church since August 11, 1991.

St. Edmund has grown into a meaningful and vibrant part of the Warren community. But community involvement does not stop at the doors of St. Edmund. Many of its members are active participants in religious, educational and public service organizations throughout the community.

The architectural design of the church building personifies the spirit of its people as a focal point of leadership commitment and involvement in this community. It emphasizes the importance of people as the church and not the building. The phrases "We are Church, We are Family, We Build Bridges, We seek Peace" are not just words, but the very foundation of what has made δt . Edmund an exceptional community of faith.

St. Edmund The Martyr (849 - 870)



Edmund was born in 849, a descendant of the preceding king of East Anglia. Though only about 15 years old when crowned in 865, Edmund showed himself to be a model ruler, treating all justly. He was always eager to pray and even retired for one year to learn the whole Psalter, so he might recite it regularly.

In 1870 he repulsed invaders, who soon returned with huge numbers of soldiers. To avert a fruitless massacre, he disbanded his troops. On his way to Framlingham he was captured and chained. He rejected his enemy's impious demands, declaring his religion dearer to him than his life. He was beaten, tied to a tree and whipped. Throughout these tortures, he continued to call upon the name of Jesus. His enemies continued

to discharge arrows at him, until they demanded his head be struck off. This martyrdom took place in 870 in Suffolk.

St. Edmund's feast is observed on November 20th.


