History of Dearborn Post 75

Before the cessation of hostilities in 1945, a group of veterans returning home banded together to form a Post. On April 10, 1945, Dearborn Post 75 became a reality. The Post began its operation with welcoming all World War II veterans into the fold.

At the beginning, meetings were held at Woodrow Wilson Post 2 until such time as they were able to purchase their own building in Dearborn. Charter for Post 75 was granted on January 24, 1946. When Edward Szymanski brought it back from Chicago.

The first officers of the Post were:

Early projects of the infant Post were Easter and Thanksgiving Day dances. Chairman of those affairs were Chester Opalinski and Emil Magier.

Since its inception, Dearborn Post 75 has been interested in education. During the term of its second Commander, Edmund Nycek, the first scholarship was awarded to a student in Chadsey High.

Our first representation at a National PLAV convention occurred in August 31, 1946. The Post was represented by Adam Szymanski, Edward Szymanski, Walter Klatt and Ted Sokol. Raymond Marciniak and Edmund Nycek were alternates.

With its expanding membership, activities increased; a bowling league was organized, growing into one of the Post's most popular programs. From its modest beginnings under Adam Szymanski in 1947, the league grew to 16 teams.

Organization of the Post picnic - which also expanded into an annual event.

Pinochle Tournament - yes we had one of them.

Blessing of the Colors on April 27, 1952.

Formation of our newspaper, The Postscript. Our first editor was Edwin Piesko, succeeded by Joseph Krolik. Ervin Ostrowski, Ted Zbizek and now Ruth Przebienda, who is doing an outstanding job.

In 1956, the Ladies Auxiliary was formed with Jean Dybicki as its first of President. The original organization of the Chapter was under the leadership of Elizabeth Piesko. The Chapter has given many hours of service in Hospital work, service to the USO, participation in parades and all Post function. Their help to the Post has been unstinting and they have been generous in their financial assistance.

The year 1960 was to prove to be a banner for the Post., Finally, after 14 years, we were to realize our ambition to purchase our own building at 7900 Greenfield in Dearborn. The purchase of the building generated such enthusiasm among our members who gave so generously of their time and money. Our membership doubled and our activities expanded.

The Post Ritual Team was formed on March 16, 1964 with 12 members. Ed Fogell was its first and present Captain. Our Ritual Team has won many awards for outstanding performance and service, not only within our immediate communities, but also at State and National Conventions.

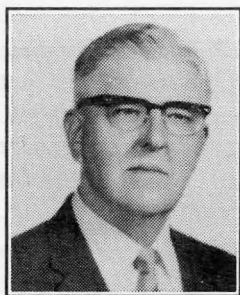
In January 1969, conclusive plans were made and adopted under the leadership of Frank Petholsky, a new hall became a reality. In January 1969, ground was broken and the new Post Memorial home began to take shape. On December 31, 1969, although not fully completed, the first New Year's Eve Party was held in the new hall.

Helen Flory was the first female veteran to join the Post, while Mabel Steffke was the first female Post Commander.

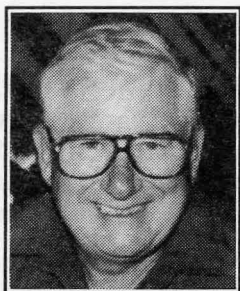
The Post was honored over the years with four Past State Commanders. They were N. Frank Cylkowski, Julius Dybicki, Adam Szymanski and Frank Petholsky. On the National level, the Post was delighted to have N. Frank Cylkowski and Norman Lelo as National Commander.

Over the years, many members, living and deceased, contributed to the success of the Post. Names can be mentioned, but someone could be forgotten because so many helped out. We became the largest Post in the PLAV because of our members. Our half century has been crowned with many achievements - we look to the future with confidence and enthusiasm.

To commemorate this memorable occasion of our Golden Anniversary, a banquet was held on April 30, 1995 with Edwin F. Piesko as Master of Ceremonies.



EDWARD A. SZYMANSKI was elected as First Commander of Post 75 in 1945. With help from Post 2, Ed organized and nurtured Post 75 from infancy to maturity. Maturity came in 1958 during the second term of Ed, when he used his financial expertise and obtained the financing necessary for the purchase of Post 75 at 7900 Greenfield. His leadership was and always will be the mainstay of Post 75.



JOSEPH KROLIK, Commander twice, was only 23 years old when he became Commander of Post 75 and Manager of Post 75's famous award winning Drum and Bugle Corp. A Commander, who believed in social activity, activated a few colossal social functions like the Dinner Dance in the Carmen Theater and a LIVE Variety show at Chadsey. With energy to spare, Joe's contributions to the Post were many, but the one he will always be remembered for is his contribution as Postscript Editor for five years. Joe was an energetic Commander that gave all his energy to Post 75.



ADAM J. SZYMANSKI, one of the earlier Commanders of Post 75, was blessed with the ability of stimulating membership. When Adam was Commander, the growth of the membership was phenomenal, from 88 members to almost 300 in just three years.

He knew that you could never over-emphasize the importance of social functions. Bringing out membership together under favorable conditions was the magic that Adam used to build an everlasting Post that was then and is now the GREATEST.



BILL TAJER as Post Commander, accepted the challenge of hard work and dedication for four years - 1971-1972, 1973-1976. During his tenure the consolidation of Woodrow Wilson Post 2 into Post 75 took place, making Post 75 into the largest Post with over 525 members. He took pride in every venture encountered by the Post and recognized that success came because of the support, hard work and dedication of the membership and officers of Post 75.

Bill knew that sometimes he would be discouraged by the difficulties and challenges that he faced. But he would never waiver from his basic goal of service to the community, hospitalized veterans and members of PLAV. He would succeed because he decided to.

On April 1, 1995, Bill Tajer passed away.



JOSEPH (DICK) GURTOWSKI, Commander for three years, will be remembered for the many distinct accomplishments that occurred during his administration. Some of the achievements during his reign as Commander were, Memorial Home became free and clear, first childrens Christmas Party and a key card system for the Lounge. Dick as a leader, not always was liked but always admired.



RON KUSTRA, Commander for two years - 1991-1993, held all elected offices during his eleven years as a member of Post 75. His enthusiasm in working for the Post would often get him into trouble, especially with the Dearborn Fire Department. Involved with Post activities beyond his wildest dreams, Ron is truly one of the greatest.



RAY GUTOWSKI, Commander for one year in 1993, was very active in hospital services for the veterans. Also hosted the National Zone II meeting held at the Post Memorial Home. Ray was a proud Commander with courage to make the right decisions for the good of the Post.



Because of the strength that respect and comradeship provides, our Chapter has successfully survived forty years of challenges. With strength from within and with the Post membership always by our side, let us continue to serve those in need, especially our hospitalized veterans.

History of Dearborn Chapter 75

Chapter 75 was organized under the leadership of Elizabeth Piesko, State Department President, who administered the oath of office to our first Chapter President, Jean Dybicki on October 30, 1955. There were twenty members in the Chapter originally, and there are six ladies remaining who are Charter Members: Dorothy Latka, Irene Krolik, Frances Fogell, Vivian Fryc, Joan Biegalski and Stella Babinski.

The ladies originally started working with the USO by volunteering their time for cooking and entertaining. Honored for their voluntary time and work, by receiving a USO Pin, were: Vivian Fryc, Marie Kozlowski and Dorothy Latka.

In 1973, the Ladies started to visit and Volunteer at the Allen Park VA Hospital. At the present time, we service three Wards in the Hospital, serving refreshments and playing Bingo with the Veterans. We work at the Country Store, Auditorium Parties and the Summer Carnival held at the Hospital. We have an Off-Station Party with Dinner, entertainment and games at our Memorial Home for the Veterans from Allen Park VA Hospital during Hospital Month, each year.

There are also Annual Visits to Battle Creek and Ann Arbor VA Hospitals, we take food and "goodies" for the veterans at these hospitals; we also donate monies for the Wheelchair Olympics.

For the forty years of existence, we have raised funds from Card Parties, Raffles, Bake Sales, Dances and other social functions. We have sold Poppies on Poppy Days, and helped the Veterans of Post 75 by helping them serve their Dinners, as well as working with them in the Kitchen in the Polish Tent during the Annual Dearborn Homecoming Event.

We have in our Chapter, two past State Presidents: Vivian Fryc and Joan Biegalski. Carol Brzostek is the present State Department President. We have one past National President: Vivian Fryc. Our Present Chapter President is Pauline Yurke.

The past forty years of our Auxiliary have not been without sorrow. We remember our Deceased Members with prayers and gratefully acknowledge their contributions to the growth of our Auxiliary. May They Rest in Peace.

This History was composed to the best of our knowledge. If any names or events are omitted, this was not intentional.
