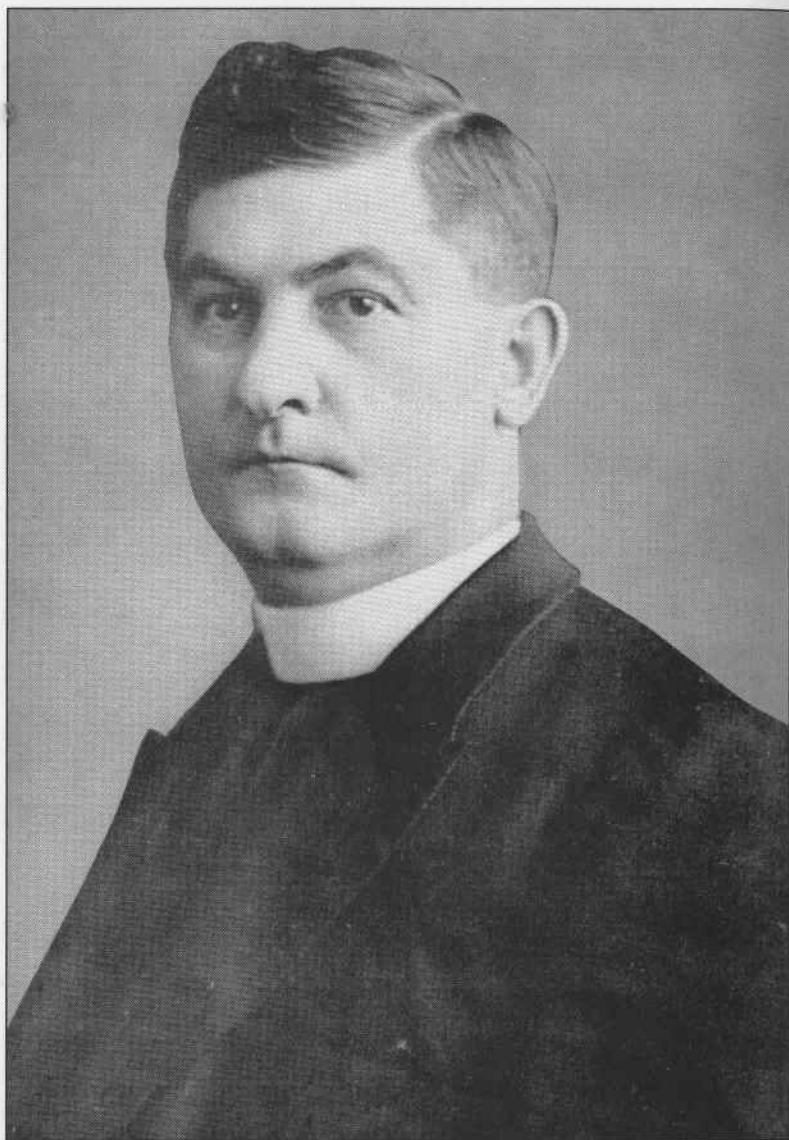

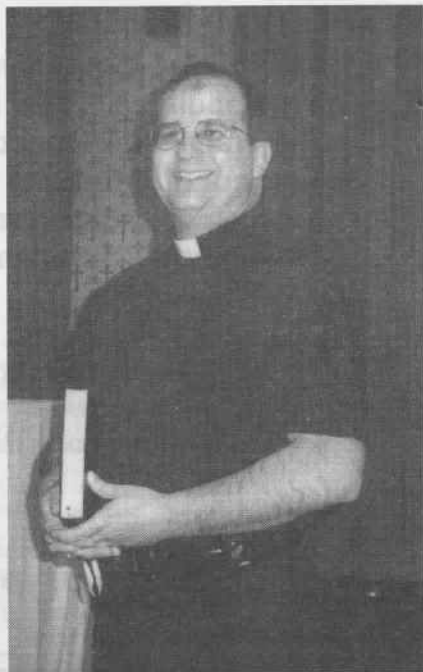

We gather on this joyful day to rejoice and give thanks that God has blessed us over the past 100 years and may continue to surround us with His love forever.

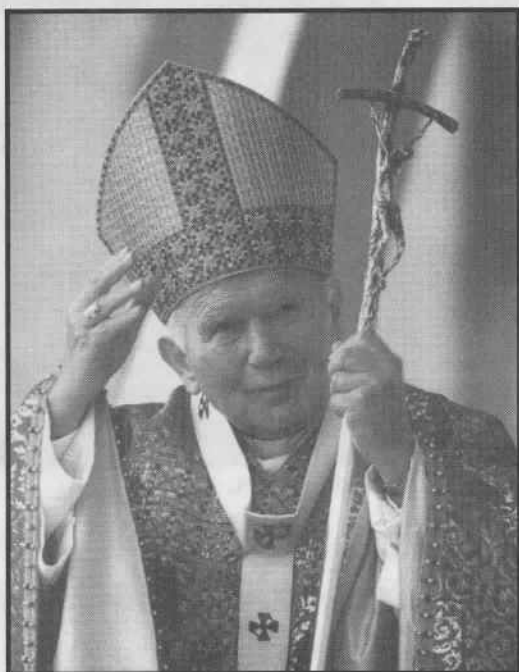

## PLENARY INDULGENCE

Granted Forever by Pope Pius X on May 12, 1907, to the Faithful Visiting  
St. Casimir's Church, Johnstown, Pa.

This church is privileged to extend the Plenary Indulgence to the Faithful "Toties Quoties," every day, as often as they visit this church. This Plenary Indulgence is also known as the "Portiuncula" indulgence or as the Grand Pardon of Assisi.

This church is privileged to extend to the Faithful the very same indulgences enjoyed by the Basilica of St. Peter's in Rome.

All Altars—Main, Side, Chapel, or any other Altar—are privileged Altars.

This Plenary Indulgence can be applied to one's self as well as to the souls in Purgatory.

In order to gain the extraordinary privileges the following conditions must be observed:

1. The Faithful who wish to obtain this indulgence must be of contrite heart. To insure this spirit an act of contrition should be made.
2. Those who doubt whether they are in the state of grace or not are advised to go to Confession and receive Holy Communion. Such Confession and Communion can be received in any church. Weekly or semi-monthly Confessions are considered sufficient prerequisites to gain the Plenary Indulgence.
3. The visiting of any part of this church, chapel or choir loft is sufficient to gain the Indulgence.
4. During the visit it is sufficient to offer any prayer or supplication, or five Our Fathers, five Hail Marys and Glory be to Father, etc.
5. The Faithful will offer these prayers: 1. For the preservation of peace among Christian nations. 2. For the expurgation of heresy. 3. For the advancement of the Catholic Church. It will suffice to say even one Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory be to Father, etc., for the intention of the Holy Father in order to gain this Plenary Indulgence.
6. In order to gain this Plenary Indulgence more than once a day it is only necessary to go and return.

This Indulgence can be gained not only by the members of this congregation, but by any one who makes a visit to this church, and it can be applied not only to one's self, but to the souls in Purgatory.
