- 1—The Parish of Saint Albert the Great was started June 24, 1955.
- 2—The Sacrament of Baptism has been administered to 117 persons.
- 3—The Sacrament of Confirmation was received by 16 adults.
- 4—There are ten Committeemen appointed by Cardinal Mooney for this parish.
- 5—There are now seven Victoryknoll Sisters teaching religion to children enrolled in the Public Schools.
- 6—There will be five Sisters of the Society of Mary to provide religion education in September, 1956.
- 7—This parish consists of 863 families.
- 8—This parish has already had four weddings.

Father DePlaunty, the first Pastor of the Parish of Saint Albert the Great. He was born in suburban Kawkawlin, Michigan, March 1, 1911. He studied at St. Michael School, Flint, Sacred Heart Seminary, Detroit, St. Mary Seminary, Norwood, Ohio. He was ordained June 7, 1936 by the late Bishop Gallagher. After serving in various assistant posts of the diocese, Cardinal Mooney appointed and commissioned him to organize the new parish of Saint Albert the Great.

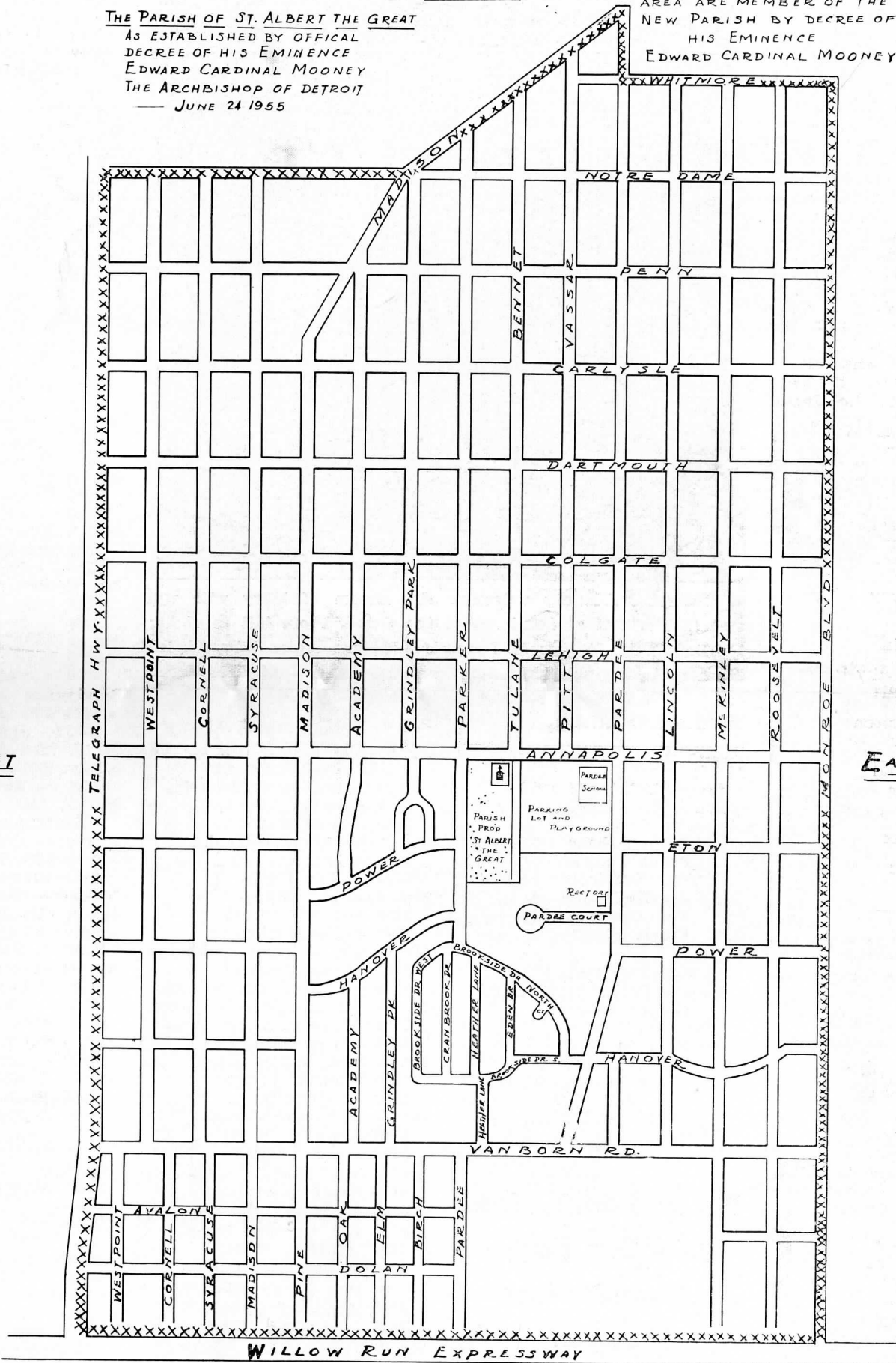

TRINITY SUNDAY

"In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost."

The feast of the most Holy Trinity is a fitting epilogue to the coming of the Holy Ghost on Pentecost. His coming was the crowning work of the redemption. Under the guidance of the Holy Ghost the Apostles received their final command to preach the gospel not to any individual nation as of old, but to all nations. They were to do this in the name of the most Holy Trinity.

God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Ghost. One God in three divine persons. We call it the mystery of the most Holy Trinity, the fundamental dogma of our entire faith. Ordinarily we begin to teach beginners the simplest, the least abstract things first like the A, B, C's. But in religion Christ himself commands to begin with the most abstract, the profoundest of all mysteries of our Holy Religion.

What is the mystery of the Holy Trinity? By the Holy Tri-

nity we mean that there is one God in three divine persons, Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. All three are equal and one in essence and substance; all three are God from all eternity; the Son proceeding from the Father, and the Holy Ghost proceeding from the Father and the Son.

We are surrounded by mysteries in the natural order and use them daily. The intricate secrets are and remain restricted to scholars and scientists, why then should any

one object to mysteries in the supernatural order? St. Vincent de Paul says: "The more one fixes one's eyes on the Sun, the less one sees it."

It is common knowledge that most people believe in a God, the first person of the Holy Trinity. Jesus, the second person, proved that he is God by many miracles, especially by His resurrection from the dead. The Holy Spirit demonstrated his divine power on Pentecost, and has done so many times since then through the Church.
