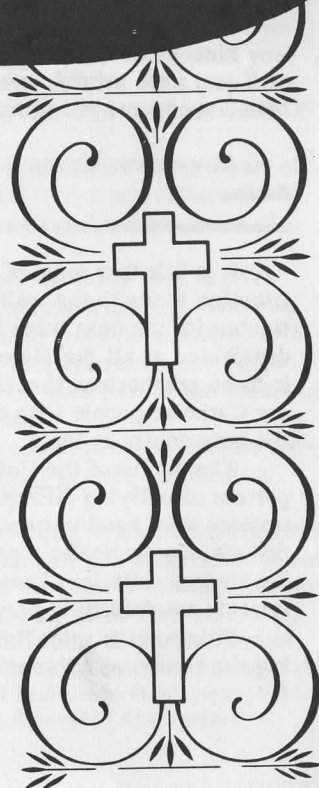

## Chatting With The Parish

### SOME THINGS WE CAN'T IGNORE



Becoming a pastor and the spiritual father over a parish is, perhaps, a thought and desire in the heart of every young priest. They are aware however, that usually there are many years of serving the Lord as assistants to pastors in various parishes before the day of pastoral assignment arrives.

By the time the assignment does come the young priest has probably served Christ anywhere from fifteen to twenty years or more, and he has learned that his duties shall now become heavier with responsibility. From that day on there will be fewer and fewer moments of relaxation from his pastoral duties.

Seldom ever does a pastor regret his "job", as we may modestly call his many duties, is the one in which he must call upon his people to give money. Sadly enough, there never seems to be any end in sight for our needs, or the needs of the many charities, missions, and particularly the Diocesan Shepherd.

Although today, May 20th, is supposed to be the wind-up day for the A.D.F. drive, we cannot accept it as such. St. Clement Parish, large in number, capable financially, and usually most generous, has fallen poorly behind in this particular drive.

We have made our appeals. No one, we are certain, is unfamiliar with the work of the A.D.F.; no one, that is, in the great Archdiocese of Michigan. Certainly everyone at St. Clement is very well informed.

We must emphasize that this is not a time in which any of us should relax in our efforts or generosity toward supporting the works of the Church. At NO TIME does Satan, and his forces of evil, ever let up. It would be shameful of us to give aid and comfort to the arch enemy of Christ by even allowing him to think for a moment that we gave only weak and passive support to our Archbishop rather than strong and generous support.

Please think seriously about this and if your offering was below that which you could well-afford, or if you were missed, come forward and make that short trip to the Administration Office on Engleman Avenue and put things right .. so far as you are concerned.

As we stated at the top .. there are some things we cannot ignore, the A.D.F. drive is one of them.

It is felt that some of our people do not properly understand nor fully appreciate the splendid contribution made to the welfare of our nation by our Catholic school system. Beginning today and continuing for the next three Sundays, a small brochure dealing with some phase of this question will be distributed at all the Masses. You are urged to read these brochures and keep them for reference. It is to be emphasized that the sole purpose underlying the distribution of these brochures is to acquaint our Catholic people with the true nature of our Catholic school system and the service it renders to the community at large.

The genius of the United States is the ability to unify minorities without destroying them. This pattern of unifying different resources is also evident in American education. Different educational systems work hand in hand in serving a common goal, the education of young citizens. Public and private schools render a public service by providing education for citizenship and by imparting to the student sufficient knowledge to enable him to fulfill his proper role in society. In this, the two systems are definitely partners.

This point is splendidly illustrated in the brochure to be distributed this morning entitled "Serving the Nation as a Partner in American Education".
