The Queen

Blessed Cunegunda, daughter of King Beli IV was brought up in a very pious atmosphere and, as a child, was a virtuous one, mortifying and fasting. She had a special devotion to Our Blessed Mother and spent many hours praying to Her.

In her youth, she had decided not to marry, but being persuaded, consented to marry King Boleslaus of Poland, at whose side she could accomplish a great deal for the poor and the needy.

King Boleslaus, drawn by her saintly life, agreed to a life of chastity, and both labored for the good of their people and the salvation of their own souls. They built convents and schools and contributed great sums to them.


She deprived herself of many luxuries, avoided parties, instead visited the sick, consoled the oppressed, helped the poor. To improve the economy of the country she brought miners from her country, opening salt mines in Bochnia and Wieliczka. She shared with her husband King Boleslaus of Poland the sufferings to which the Tartar invasion subjected the land. She gave her dowry to arm the armies against the assault of the enemy.


After the death of her husband, she entered the Convent of the Franciscans in 1279. She died a Franciscan tertiary in the nunnery she had founded at Sandiez.

Many miracles resulted from her intercession. Pope Alexander III decreed and proclaimed her Patroness of Poles.


Her feastday is July 24.


1927

Aug. 3 — Father Alexander Wilczewski assumes post as first pastor of the newly founded St. Cunegunda Parish after Stanley Biernat, John Kowalec, Paul Smoter, Stanley Styka, and John Witalec present petitions to Bishop Michael Gallagher.

Aug. 11 — Fr. Wilczewski purchases 15 lots (35 x 126), on which the parish buildings are eventually erected, at a cost of \$32,000.

Aug. 25 — Permission granted to erect temporary church.

Aug. 28 — Blessing of the plot on which temporary church will stand . . .
Carl Filip, Contractor — Gorsztecki, Architect



Oct. 23 — Services held for the first time in church. Most Rev. James Plagens dedicates new church. 8,000-10,000 are said to have attended the dedication.



Pastor resides in house next to church.



Oct. 24 — Three lay teachers commence classes for 127 boys and 140 girls. Classes are held in church.

Dec. 31 — Mother Adelaide, from the community of Sisters of St. Francis from Sylvania, Ohio, sends six sisters to the parish — Sr. Henrieta (principal), Sr. Albina, Sr. Francesca, Sr. Maximilia, Sr. Stanislaus, Sr. Victoria.

January 1 — Joseph Turowski donates his home for the Sisters' Convent, 5873 St. Lawrence.



September 19 — Two corner lots on Kirkwood and St. Lawrence are purchased by Fr. Wilczewski. The purchase price — \$4,300.

November 18-27 — First Parish Bazzarr held at 5873 St. Lawrence.

1929

Fr. Wilczewski organizes a building committee for a school. Mr. Joseph Gwiazdowski, an architect presents sketches and plans for the new school building which are soon accepted and approved by Bishop Gallagher.

1930

April 27 — Ground blessed and broken for new school. Each family pledges \$100.00 for the school building fund. School building fund committee: John Witalec, Joseph Milewski, Stanley Oleszkowicz, Joseph Jaje, Stanley Styka, Paul Smoter, John Kowalec, Carl Filip (contractor) Joseph Cichostemski, Carl Lisowski, Frank Misiak, Emil Burek, Joseph Kubinski, Stanley Zboch, Adam Szczesny, Sr., Joseph Brudzinski.



June 10 — Work began on the 12 classroom school.

June 15 — Cornerstone placed by Fr. Joseph Herr and Fr. Wilczewski.






August 24 — Blessing of the statue of St. Anthony

1953

March 1 — Edward Cardinal Mooney dedicates the new buildings



1957

September 30 — Parish celebrates its 30th Jubilee Year. Worth of parish is over \$1,000,000.00.

1958

September 21 — Cardinal Mooney orders a parish wide census to be taken beginning October 5th.

1959

December 6 — Msgr. Maximilian Gannas blesses paintings in the Church which are painted by Mr. and Mrs. Carl Malczyk.

A Banquet is held in school hall.

1963

September 30 — Parish celebrates 35th Jubilee Year



- November 8 — Fr. Wilczewski offered his last Mass, received the Viaticum from his own hands, collapses at the altar, and dies.
- November 11 — Solemn pontifical requiem Mass is offered by Bishop Henry E. Donnelly, assisted by Msgr. Peter P. Walkowiak, Fr. Joseph Karasiewicz, Fr. Andrew Nieckarz, Fr. Bronislaus Siepak. The Eulogies are delivered by Fr. Stanley Borucki and Fr. Zdzislaus Peszkowski.

1964

- January — Archbishop John Dearden appoints Fr. Stanley F. Borucki to succeed the late Fr. Wilczewski as pastor of St. Cunegunda Parish.
- January 26 — Fr. Borucki is installed as new pastor by Msgr. Arthur Karey. Installation Banquet is held March 1st.
- February 23 — Archbishop John F. Dearden grants permission to engage the services of Diehl and Diehl to prepare plans and specifications for the new convent.
- March 29 — Parish introduces weekly church envelopes for the first time.
- June 15 — Repairing and remodeling of school building begins at a cost of \$42,000.00. The latest features in the field of education are installed.
- October 19 — Parish parking lots are resurfaced. The two lots on Elmer are dedicated as the Fr. Alexander S. Wilczewski Memorial Playground.



- December 27 — Groundbreaking for new Sisters' Convent is held.

1965

March 27 — The new church liturgy is introduced into the parish.

June 20 — Parish celebrates the Silver Jubilee at the ordination of Fr. Borucki. A banquet and reception are held on June 27.



November — The church choir, under the direction of Mr. Emil Gugala, prepares an album of 18 most popular Christmas carols and shepherds' songs to mark 1,000 years of Poland's acceptance of Christianity. 3,500 records are sold.

1966

April 19 — Msgr. Walter R. Hardy blesses the new convent and dedicates the chapel.



July — Parish signs contract with Wicks Organ Company for a new church organ. The cost is about \$22,000.00.

1967

- June 4 – Newly installed organ is dedicated. The guest organist is Stanley Zydek.
- September 17 – A Solemn Mass of thanksgiving is offered to observe the Fortieth Anniversary of the founding of the Parish. The Statue in front of the Sisters' Convent is blessed.
- September 17 – December 5 – The parish begins participation in the Archdiocesan Synod Program which updated the Archdiocese in keeping with the decrees of the Second Vatican Council. Parish voting on proposals continue into 1968.



1969

- January 5 – Parish begins "Design for '69." Parishioners agree to give an additional 25 cents per week in their Sunday envelopes in lieu of extra collections thus becoming a project parish for Archdiocese (discontinued in 1974.)
- February 3 – Fr. Borucki begins program to pay a visit to the homes of parishioners, to meet with them and bless their house.
- June 14 – The Church Committee votes to paint the interior of the church (Ben Ryll, artist.) The ceiling loses its blue hue and takes on more off-white. The purgatory scene is obliterated leaving only the Blessed Mother picture.
- July 9 – Parish establishes a scholarship fund at the Orchard Lake Schools.

1971

November — Windows are replaced in the front of the school. School hall, meeting room, and kitchen are tiled. Improvements to the school building continue with carpeting of all classrooms in 1972.

March 23 — Fr. Stanley Borucki dies. Concelebrated Funeral Mass is March 28, at 11:00 a.m.



June 18 — Fr. Francis Zdrodowski assumes pastoral duties at St. Cunegunda.

June 23 — Bishop Krawczak installs St. Cunegunda Parish's third pastor, Rev. Francis J. Zdrodowski.



September 4 — Parish Council approves a scholarship fund for female students at the Sisters' Motherhouse in Sylvania, Ohio, as well as, a permanent portable altar in the Church. The Altar is completed by October 20. Additional improvements are made by Fr. Zdrodowski in the church, rectory, and school hall. Landscaping the parish grounds takes place in 1975.
