



The altar is now prepared. When it is time to light the candles, a light is taken from the Paschal Candle as the Bishop prays: "Light of Christ, shine forth in the Church and bring all nations to the fullness of truth."

The light from the Paschal Candle is used to light the candles throughout the congregation as well as the altar candles.)
