WE HONOR OUR PATRON, ST. MALACHY

St. Malachy, whose family name was O'Morgais, was born in Armagh, Ireland in 1094 of noble birth.

He was commissioned to revive the abbey of Bangor in Down in 1123.

The following year, he was made bishop of the neglected diocese of Connor. He pursued both tasks vigorously.

In 1129 he was nominated to be the archbishop of Armagh.

He was unable to take full possession of his see because he was violently opposed by representatives of the family in which the monastery and church of Armagh has been hereditary for generations.

He was more than once in danger of his life.

St. Malachy restored Armagh to the abbot of Derry in 1137.

In 1139, he went to Rome to obtain the archepiscopal pall for the sees of Armagh and Cashel; in this he was unsuccessful, but Pope Innocent II appointed him papal legate for Ireland.

On both his outward and inward journeys, he visited St. Bernard at Clairvaux, leaving four of his companions there to be trained. With these monks and others he founded the abbey of Mellifont in Louth; the first Cistercian house in Ireland. He also introduced canons regularly into that country.

For eight years, St. Malachy was active in the exercise of his legatine authority, and then in 1148 set out again for Rome in quest of the palls. On the way, he became ill at Clairvaux and died in the arms of St. Bernard.

St. Bernard said of him that "his first and greatest miracle was himself. His inward beauty, strength and purity by his life; there was nothing in his behavior that could offend anyone."

The so-called Prophecies of St. Malachy, characterizing future popes, are a sixteenth century forgery.

St. Malachy was the first Irish Saint to be canonized by Pope Clement on July 6, 1199. His feast is celebrated on November 3.

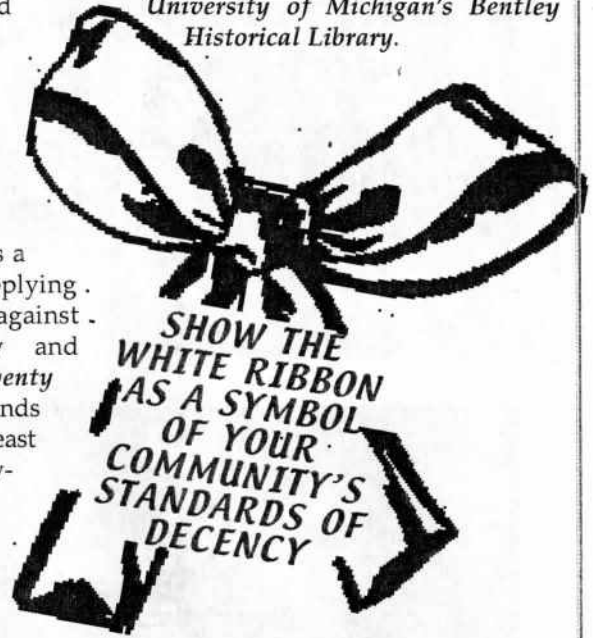


RIGHT TO DECENCY, CONT.

Right to Decency, Inc. began monthly meetings in 1985 under the leadership of Mary Ellen Gavin at St. Malachy parish with the blessing of the Pastor, Fr. Gerald Britz and the encouragement of Bette Jannott, Religious Director. The goal was to promote a healthy moral community environment by educating the public about the harms of pornography and obscenity and to give people tools such as the knowledge that existing laws could curtail the distribution of it. A first victory was the elimination of pornographic magazines from an 80-drugstore chain in Michigan. The group incorporated in 1993 and received a grant from the archdiocese, operating from a Roseville office until November of 2005. They produced a quarterly educational newsletter and operated an extensive Website. Some efforts included an annual awareness *White Ribbon against Pornography Campaign* with distribution of white ribbons as a

symbol of decency. They had ongoing communications with U.S. and state legislators and testified at hearings. They pressured, boycotted and picketed advertisers and corporations for wholesome television and radio. They set a precedent by obtaining the largest fine possible from the *Federal Communications Commission* against indecent Detroit radio. They operated as a Resource Center, supplying information for working against pornography and obscenity and involved approximately *seventy* archdiocese parishes and thousands of dedicated volunteers in southeast Michigan during their twenty-year history. They implemented the suggestions of the U.S. Catholic Bishops "*Renewing the Mind of the Media: A Statement on Overcoming the Exploitation of Sex and*

Violence in Communication." The public can now access Right to Decency records and documents at the *University of Michigan's Bentley Historical Library.*

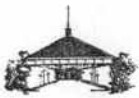

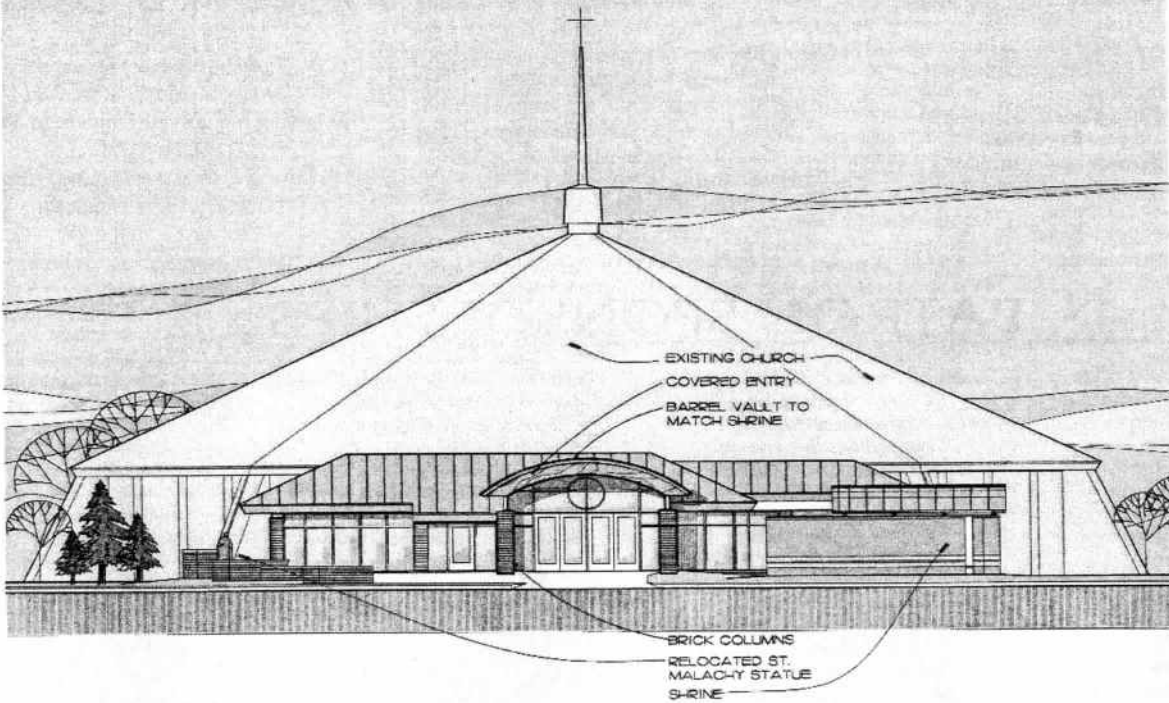

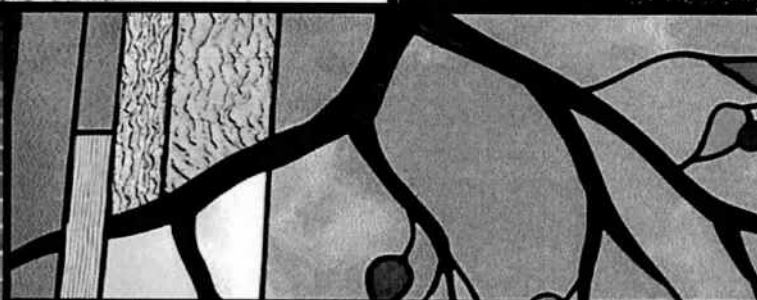
