

SAINT STANISLAUS

Bishop and Martyr

Each May 8th the Catholic people remember a hero. He was not a great leader on the battle-field, statesman or man of science. This hero, St. Stanislaus, was a bishop and a martyr. He died at the hands of his king when he dared to place God's rights above those of the state.

Stanislaus became a martyr because he wanted to save the soul of King Boleslaw the Brave, who was living in sin with a woman. An able monarch, who did much for his people. Boleslaw was also known to be a sensualist and a man of great passion. Some say he was also a tyrant and despot, without a sense of justice.

Stanislaus was born in 1030 in Little Poland. After studying in Gniezno he went to Paris. Shortly after his ordination he was named canon of the Cathedral of Krakow. After the death of his friend and protector, Bishop Lambert, St. Stanislaus was elected bishop of Krakow.

As bishop, Stanislaus shone for his deep interest in saving the souls entrusted to him. In each person he saw the immortal soul which must be saved for God. So, despite the realization that he was facing overwhelming odds, he bravely fought for Boleslaw the

Brave's soul, despite the king's own wishes.

When entreaties failed, Bishop Stanislaus resorted to his strongest weapon. He excommunicated the king.


This brave step cost the bishop his life. On April 11, 1079, while he was celebrating Mass in the Church on the Rock (St. Michael's) in Krakow, not far from the royal palace, a group of knights were ordered by the king to kill St. Stanislaus. They entered the church. St. Stanislaus, with his back to them, was at the altar. As the knights reached the altar and endeavored to carry out the king's order an invisible power threw them to the floor and they scarcely managed to crawl out of the church. When they tried to reenter the church the invisible power seized them again.

Furious with anger, King Boleslaw himself ran into the church. He dashed to the altar and struck St. Stanislaus in the back of the head with his sword. The king's aides then dragged the bishop's body outside the church edifice and began to chop it apart.

Bishop Stanislaus died in an unequal battle. His death as a martyr has made his name live until today, praised by the generations which followed him.

The History of . .

ST. STANISLAUS CHURCH IN LUBLIN, WISCONSIN

Drawn by the cheap prices of land and the springing up of sawmills and logging camps, the first settlers who were immigrants from Europe came to Lublin, to clear the land, began farming and organized into a small community at the beginning of the year 1902.

A hardy life presented itself for the early Catholic settlers. There were no bridges or roads in those days. The Catholic settlers of Lublin attended church services in Thorp, Wisconsin, a distance of twelve miles. Despite the hardships and the small number of Catholics, an attempt had been made by the inhabitants of Lublin, to locate a Catholic Church.

A petition had been sent to Most Reverend A. Schinner, D. D., Bishop of Superior Diocese, in 1907, requesting that a Catholic Church be built in Lublin. The land and the lumber for the construction of the church had been donated by the State Land Co. With the Bishop's consent, the Church was built and completed in 1908.

The first pastor of the Catholic Church in Lublin was Father T. F. Malecki. He was followed for a short term by the Reverend B. J. Barca. During the pastorate of these two priests, a span of three years, the rectory was erected.

In July af 1911, The Reverend Stanislaus Topolski had been assigned to succeed Father Malecki, as Pastor. His friendliness towards people drew people to church. A born organizor, a friend to all, Father Topolski organized various parish societies, developed the cemetery, had the church painted and decorated. He ended his priestly stay at St. Stanislaus Parish, gloriously in the eyes of God as well as with the parishioners and non-parishioners.

The Reverend L. S. Nowacki succeeded Father Topolski in April of

1916. Soon after Father Nowacki arrived, he tackled the problem of purchasing a new Altar and completing the interior of the rectory. The short stay of Father Nowacki was a great benefit to the parishioners.

In 1916, The Reverend P. Raczaszek became pastor. His first task was the improvement of the cemetery and the exterior decorating of the church.

Rev. John Balcer arrived in March of 1922. Not long after his coming to Lublin, fire leveled the rectory. At a meeting on May 17th, with Father Balcer presiding, it was resolved that the construction of a new rectory begin immediately.

In 1931 Rev. Joseph Rapala assumed the 15 year pastoral care of the parish. During this time, the church was raised and set on a new foundation, a church hall was constructed and some improvements in the rectory were made. His memory is a reverent one in the minds and hearts of all whom he served.

A four and a half year term was granted to the Reverend Thaddeus Augustyn who followed Father Rapala as Pastor in the year 1946. A new roof for the church and the rectory was put on under the supervision of Father Augustyn. Religious and social activities of the parish were carried out normally at this time.

During the pastorate of Reverend Eugene Konopka (1950-1961) through the combined efforts of the Reverend Father and his people, life and activity were breathed into this society. Spiritual attention to his people and sponsoring of many church benefits must be credited to his leadership and zeal. Father Konopka realized the need of a new church in Lublin. Permission for the construction of a new church was given to Father Konopka by the Bishop of the Superior Diocese. Construction began in June of 1961.

Arriving to Lublin as the foundation for the church was being poured, was Father Edward T. Cyz, who assumed the spiritual leadership of the parish on June 21, 1961. Father Edward Cyz is a native of Chicago. He attended the St. Pancratius Parochial School in Chicago. He received his High School education and College at the La Salette Seminary in Olivet, Illinois. Father Cyz completed his Theological studies at the Gregorian University in Rome, Italy and was ordained to the Priesthood in Rome in 1954.

The completion of the new church in Lublin was realized under the direction and supervision of Father Edward T. Cyz.


