

History

OF ST. STANISLAUS KOSTKA PARISH

* * * * *

The St. Stanislaus Kostka Parish is the Mother Church of all the Polish Churches within the diocese of Pittsburgh, Pa. As far back as 1872, many Polish families were scattered throughout the area. Some of these attended services at St. Wenceslaus on the North Side. others were members of the St. Michaels Parish on the South Side. It was at the St. Michaels Parish that first missionary priest Father Stanislaus of the Passionist Monastery, resided. It was he who took care of the spiritual needs of the Polish people in Pittsburgh. In 1873. the St. Stanislaus Beneficial Society was established. This organization was instrumental in bringing Father Klawiter to Pittsburgh. They originally invited him to hear the Easter Confessions. On August 15, 1875, the Bishop appointed Father Klawiter to organize the parish. He purchased the old Presbyterian Church, on 15th St. and Penn Ave., in October, 1875. The church was dedicated in November of that same year, naming St. Stanislaus Kostka as the Patron of the Parish.

At the present time there are four flourishing parishes that were formed from this church. These are, the Immaculate Heart, founded in July 1897; Holy Family, October 1902; St. Hyacinth, August 1916; St. Cyprian, March 1920.

In 1877 Father Klawiter was succeeded by Fathers Bratkiewicz, Graza, Parzych and Hyacinth O. S. B. Then came Fathers Lebiecki and Thomas O. S. B. Carolus O. M. Cap Lauth C. S. C. On December 19, 1886, the Bishop appointed Father Anthony Jaworski C. S. Sp., of the Holy Ghost order, as Pastor. In July 1887, Confirmation was administered by Bishop Phelan, for the first time in the church on 15th St. That same year the church was sold to the Knights of St. George. Lots were purchased on the corner of 22nd and Smallman Sts., for a school and convent.

A two and a half story building was also acquired to serve as rectory. In April 1888, the First High Mass was celebrated in the school hall on the third floor, used for the time being, for church purposes. In July 1888, the St. Casimir Society for the young men, was organized. And in September, the Congregation of the Children of Mary was officially established. Five Sisters of St. Charles Borromeo from Silesia took charge of the parochial school. They were succeeded by the Sisters of Nazareth of Holy Family. The first attendance consisted of 300 pupils.

In April 1891, land was purchased for a cemetery in Shaler Township and later a lot on 21st and Smallman Sts., was bought for a new church. On July 31, 1892 the new church was dedicated.

Father Jaworski was assisted successively by Fathers Gross, Weckel, Griffin, Szwarcrok, Rydlewski, Tomaszewski, Strzelczak and Alachniewicz C. S. Sp.

In 1898 Father Tomaszewski became Pastor, assisted by Fathers Alachniewicz, Kwapulinski, Rachwalski and M. Retka, C. S. Sp.

In 1907, Father Kwapulinski was installed as Pastor, assisted by Fathers Rachwalski, M. Retka, Dekowski, Lipinski, Maciejewski, M. Sonnefeld, Maniecki and Bednarczyk, C. S. Sp.

In 1927 Father M. Sonnefeld was appointed Pastor, assisted by Father Halba and Father Skibinski, C. S. Sp.

In 1928, Father Lipinski became Pastor assisted by Fathers Skibinski and Bednarczyk, C. S. Sp.

In October 1933, Father Skibinski became administrator and later was appointed Pastor. He was with the parish 13 years and is now, the only living former Pastor of this parish. His assistant was Father Bednarczyk.

On September 13, 1941, Father John Janczuk, a local boy, replaced Father Skibinski as Pastor. His assistants were, Father Zydanowicz, Father Zaborowski, Father Frommholz, Father Clemens Moroz, C. S. Sp.

On June 12, 1961 Father Joseph Skibinski was attached to St. Stanislaus.


Father Janczuk, with his untiring efforts, not taking time off for a rest or vacation, helping at the cemetery, and doing all he can to hold the parish together, even though the membership has dwindled down to approximately 160 families, certainly merited a place for himself in all of our hearts.

The school was closed in 1958 by order of Bishop Dearden.

There are five societies existing within the parish, the Rosary Society, Sodality of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Holy Name Society, the Ladies' Guild, who is sponsoring the Anniversary Jubilee and the Diocesan Council of Catholic Women.






REV. JOSEPH SKIBINSKI, C. S. Sp.

Historia

PARAFII ŚW. STANISŁAWA KOSTKI

* * * * *

Parafia Św. Stanisława Kostki jest pierwszą polską parafią w diecezji Pittsburgskiej. Do roku 1872 Polacy w Pittsburghu byli rozmieszczeni po wszystkich częściach miasta. W roku 1872 liczba Polaków powiększyła się, więc zaczęto myśleć o polskim kościele. Uchwalono na posiedzeniach, że Polacy z północnej strony miasta mieli chodzić do czeskiego kościoła (Św. Wacława), a ci z południowej strony do niemieckiego kościoła (Św. Michała), gdzie wówczas znajdował się pierwszy polski kapłan w Pittsburghu — Ojciec Stanisław, Pasjonista.

W roku 1873 założono Towarzystwo Św. Stanisława. Towarzystwo to można nazwać kolebką parafii Św. Stanisława. W roku 1874 Towarzystwo zaprosiło Ks. Klawitera do słuchania spowiedzi Wielkanocnej. Po raz drugi w 1875 zaproszono Ks. Klawitera, ale teraz, aby został ich proboszczem Ks. Biskup Tuigg zgodził się z życzeniem przeznaczył 15 sierpnia, 1875 r. Ks. Klawitera na proboszcza mającej się zorganizować parafii. W październiku 1875 kupiono kościół od Presbyterianów za \$12,500.00. W listopadzie 1875 odbyło się uroczyste poświęcenie. Patronem została Św. Stanisław Kostka.

W 1891, loty pod kościół kosztowały \$17,000.00. — Budowa kościoła, ławki, organy, ołtarze, okna itd. — \$87,891.00.

W 1900, loty pod nową plebanię i poprawki na 21-szej ulicy kosztowały \$27,000.00. — Budowa nowej plebanii kosztowała \$36,000.

W 1900 — Chodniki \$1,500.00.

W 1900 — Brama na cmentarzu \$1,200.00.



SISTER MARY MACRINA

(Rosalie Jankowski)

Sister Mary Macrina, the daughter of Valentine and Josephine (nee Skorczynski) Jankowski was born in Albany, New York on March 1, 1875. Her parents moved to Pittsburgh and settled in St. Stanislaus Parish when Sister Macrina was a small child. It was from St. Stanislaus Parish that Sister Mary Macrina entered the Felician Sisters Community then located in Detroit, Mich., on December 23, 1896. She was invested in the Felician Sisters' Habit on August 3, 1899 and pronounced her Temporary Vows the following year. In 1908 she pronounced her final vows.

After completing her Novitiate Sister Mary Macrina spent the greater part of her life in religion as teacher in various parochial schools of Michigan, and after the formation of the Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Province, she labored in the Pittsburgh and Greensburg Dioceses.

Appointed the convent seamstress, Sister served the sisters in that capacity for a number of years. Now at the age of ninety, even though her eyesight is dimming and her hearing is fading, Sister manages to brighten the days for the other religious by her cheery attitude, unfailing good humor and her prayerful spirit.


