The History of Our Church

The history and origin of Sweetest Heart of Mary Parish is quite unique and different than any other in the Archdiocese of Detroit. The parish was organized as a direct result of the political tension that existed in both the City and Archdiocese of Detroit at the end of the 19th century. This was an era of immense immigration to the United States from Europe. The immigration that took place at this time was primarily from the poorer countries of Europe, i.e. eastern and southern Europe. It was also a time of great political unrest in Europe.

The organizers of Sweetest Heart of Mary Parish were immigrants from that section of Europe that had formerly constituted the nation of Poland. At the time of the foundation of our parish Poland did not exist as a nation, but rather had been divided and ruled by the countries of Germany, Austria and Russia. The deconstruction of the Polish nation together with great poverty were the primary reasons for immigration to the United States.

At this point in its history the Archdiocese of Detroit was made up primarily of ethnic groups. Almost every parish in the archdiocese belonged to one particular ethnic group. The bishop of Detroit together with the other bishops of the United States struggled to create a Catholic Church in the United States with an American identity rather than a collection of national parishes.

In the city of Detroit, immigrants who were unable to speak English and were unfamiliar with Western European culture were to say the least treated poorly. Most did not enjoy the skills of any trade except farming. Education was also very limited. The response of these immigrants to this treatment was to establish their own ethnic communities that were centered around the parish church.

Polish immigration to Detroit began in the 1870's. The first parish was established in 1872 - St. Albertus. By the 1880's it had grown immensely. The congregation was made up of Poles from the three regions of the former nation. These groups were of themselves extremely diverse. The congregation was served by foreign born priests from its beginning. The fifth pastor of the parish was Rev. Dominic Kolasinski. He built the present church of St. Albertus.

In 1885 controversies erupted between Fr. Kolasinski, his parishioners and the bishop of Detroit, which lead to his removal as pastor of the parish. The parish was divided between supporters of the former pastor and the newly appointed pastor. In 1889 the supporters of Fr. Kolasinski organized themselves into a community and asked Fr. Kolasinski to be their spiritual leader. This was done outside of the auspices of the diocese of Detroit At its origin Sweetest Heart of Mary Parish was not in union with the Archdiocese of Detroit. The pastor and congregation were however, reconciled with the bishop and brought into the archdiocese in 1894.

The present church building was completed in 1893. A parish school was organized in 1886. In 1894 it was placed under the direction of the School Sisters of St. Francis who later became the Sisters of St. Joseph of the Third Order of St. Francis. In 1948 a parish High School was opened. The rectory on the property was built in 1901. The convent was built in 1924. The school building was added to in 1905. This wing was demolished in 1980. The High School was closed in 1966. The grade School was closed in 1975. The parish also maintains a cemetery under the title of Sacred Heart of St. Mary. This was established in 1894. The title to the Church property was in the hands of a board of trustees until it was turned over to the Archdiocese of Detroit in 1960.

Historically speaking Sweetest Heart of Mary was the third parish organized in the archdiocese to serve the Polish community. Its predecessors were St. Albertus -1872, and St. Casimir - 1882. Since both have been closed Sweetest Heart of Mary is the oldest Polish parish still in operation within the boundaries of the Archdiocese of Detroit. The parish continues to have a Polish ethnic flavor although the Polish languages enjoys only a minimal usage in worship.

The parishioners of Sweetest Heart of Mary Parish have been organizing an annual Pierogi Festival on the grounds of the church since 1983. This event has grown from a Sunday afternoon fundraiser into a two-day festival that draws hundreds and even thousands of metro-Detroiters to the grand old church at the corner of Canfield and Russell in the old Polish section of Detroit.

The origin of the Pierogi Festival was an annual school reunion Mass and picnic that was held in September to commemorate the beginning of the school year. Sweetest Heart of Mary Schools (elementary school & high school) had been existence from 1886 to 1966. During this time hundreds and hundreds of children were educated here by the Sisters of St. Joseph of the Third Order of St. Francis. The annual picnic provided alumni with an opportunity to return to their old school and visit with old friends and school faculty.

When the reunion picnic became too large the festival was created. Pierogi were chosen as the theme because they are probably the best known of all homemade and old-fashioned Polish foods. The Pierogi served at our festival are all handmade here at Sweetest Heart of Mary Church by volunteers who get together weekly. The Pierogi making team here makes hundreds of dozens every year, as they are available for sale year round! We hope you enjoy them and our festival!
